



STATE OF COLORADO

You are before the Court because a peace officer for this City has charged you with a violation of the law.

YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

1. To appear before a judge;
2. To be advised by the Court of the nature of the charges against you and of the maximum penalty;
3. To be presumed innocent of the charges, and if you plead not guilty, the prosecution must prove you guilty beyond a reasonable doubt;
4. To bail and to be advised of the amount of bail that has been set by the Court;
5. To make no statement, but that any statement made can and may be used against you;
6. To be represented by counsel, and, if indigent, the right to appointed counsel as applicable;
7. To have a trial by a jury. Such demand must be made in writing within twenty one days of entering a not guilty plea and you must pay a \$25 jury fee within 10 days of request, unless the fee is waived by the judge because of indigence. If you fail to meet the above conditions, your trial shall be to the Court;
8. To compel the attendance of witnesses on your behalf by subpoenas, issued by the Court, without expense to you;
9. To testify or not testify in your own behalf. Your silence does not imply any wrongdoing on your part and cannot be used against you;
10. To appeal any judgment within 30 days after the judgment is entered to the district and appellate courts of Colorado; however, if you plead guilty, you waive your right to appeal; and
11. To a continuance of this arraignment, for good cause shown.
