A special meeting of the Salida City Council was held this date in the Tenderfoot Conference, 448 E. 1st St. The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by Mayor Don Stephens.

ROLL CALL -

Present at roll call were Don Stephens, Council Members, Keith Baker, Steven Stewart, Jim McCormick, Jay Moore, and Mike Bowers. Also present were City Administrator Dara MacDonald and Deputy City Clerk Audrey Gilpin.

BRIDGE AS ART PROPOSALS -

Councilman Keith Baker said longevity of the bridge is important to him, and materials such as concrete and metal will increase longevity of the bridge.

McCormick said he would like Salida citizens to have an opportunity to look at the three proposals.

Moore directed staff to look into the cost of a prefabricated, basic bridge and a bridge similar to the current bridge near the SteamPlant.

Councilmen also directed staff to place three models of the proposed bridge at the Salida Regional Library and let citizens vote on which proposal they prefer. Councilmen will revisit the Bridge as Art proposals during their regular city council meeting October 2, 2012.

Moore made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 a.m. Baker seconded the motion. With all in consensus, THE MOTION CARRIED.
